



<u>Resolution 24-2016: Town Board authorizes Supervisor Fleming to execute a Memorandum of Understanding between</u> <u>The Town of Denmark and Dennis Rennie.</u>

1. The Town agrees to fund the Health Savings Account of Dennis Rennie with all sums remaining to be paid to such account during the balance of fiscal year 2016 for the Town and to fund those remaining amounts immediately.

2. Employee agrees that should employment with the Town terminate prior to the end of fiscal year 2016, Employee shall reimburse to the Town all amounts contributed to the Health Savings Account for that portion of the year that would not otherwise have been earned.

(Example: If employee terminates employment November 30, 2016 Health Savings Account contribution for December will be refunded to Town).

3. All parties and the Union agree that this is a one-time exception to the Union contract and does not constitute a past practice nor obligate the Town to make similar accommodations for other employees.

4. The Parties to this agreement and the Union agree that no other employee may file a grievance against the Town based upon the accommodation for this Employee or of the failure to provide a similar accommodation to other employees.

5. Except as modified specifically herein for Employee all other terms of the collective bargaining agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

COMPTROLLER'S REPORT: Mrs. Fleming provided the Town Board with copies of her monthly Budget Officer's Report and a financial report for April 2016.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Mayor Alexander asked the Town Board to discuss the bill that the Village of Copenhagen received for the hours and equipment provided by the Town for the "Spring Clean-up". The Village was billed \$2,613.37 in an invoice dated 5/24/2016. Discussion was held.

Supt. Mahar created the bill and another for the Village of Castorland for their clean-up day. It was his understanding that the Town of Denmark no longer wished to provide this service for no charge as concerns have been raised by Town Residents about the fairness of providing a service to Village Residents but not those outside of the Villages. Mayor Alexander asked if the Town Board was aware that the Villages were being billed. Town Board members were not involved in the billing as that is the responsibility of the Highway Supt.

Councilman Thoma asked if the Villages had been notified of the billing before the clean-up. Supt. Mahar reported that they had not. Mayor Alexander explained that this was an unplanned expense. Councilman Thoma asked about the tipping fees and Supt. Mahar explained that they are paid by the Villages. Councilman Jones asked if the Village would budget for this going forward. Mayor Alexander explained that the Village would have to investigate other options to see if any lower cost alternative could be found. He indicated that he fully understood the concerns about providing services fairly.

Councilman Thoma made a motion to discard the invoices for 2016 clean-up expenses.

Discussion continued. Concern was expressed for billing procedures for winter plowing. Mrs. Fleming had erroneously left out billing the Villages annually for snow plowing for several years and as a result the Villages did not pay. Councilman Thoma noted that with no invoice they would not be able to pay as their payable practices were similar to the Towns and they could not pay without a bill. Councilman Thoma noted that these are separate issues and should not be comingled.

Councilman Thoma made a motion to discard the invoices for 2016 clean-up expenses. Councilman Fazio seconded his motion. Vote recorded as follows:

ASSESSOR REPORT: Mr. Vargulick was present and discussed with the Town Board the grievance that has been filed by WGS Housing. They have requested a reduction from \$3,297,000.00 to \$100,000.00. He noted that an adjustment may be needed but not at that level. No occupancy rates were provided with the grievance. He will be contacting Town Attorney Gebo. Discussion was held on the method used in calculating assessment for housing complexes. Occupancy is utilized because it is an income generating property.

Mrs. Fleming exits the meeting at 7:15pm.

ZONING AND PLANNING: Members were provided with copies of ZEO Woodruff's Report for May 2016 and furnished a copy of the Planning Board minutes from May 3, 2016.

NEW BUSINESS: Clerk Kunert provided the Town Board with a copy of the letter sent by CHARTER about their takeover of Time Warner Cable.

Assessor Vargulick reenters the meeting at 7:05 PM.

HIGHWAY SUPT. REPORT: Supt. Mahar reported that the Wilson Rd will be paved next week and the shoulder of the road will be completed a month after that.

Supt. Mahar also asked the Town Board to consider a resolution against the DEC Proposed Regulation (Part 360) Solid Waste Management Facilities, in particular subpart 361-5, Material Recovery Facilities. Supt. Mahar discussed with the Town Board his concerns about the impact this regulation could have on Town of Denmark operations improving and maintaining roads. After discussion Councilman Der made a motion that a letter be drafted and sent to the DEC expressing the Town of Denmark's concerns with the proposed regulation. The motion was seconded by Councilman Jones.

Councilman Der spoke about the recent Town of Denmark Planning Board meeting that he attended on June 7th. The plans presented that night show the towers coming from Doran Road to NYS Rt 12. There is still no road agreement in place and a complete list has not yet been provided by Copenhagen Wind.

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Councilman Der expressed concern about sound issues. Mr. Mahar explained that the review is still taking place and the Planning Board can make stipulations to the permit if approved. At this time the application is still not complete. There being no more business before the Board, Councilman Thoma made a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Councilman Jones.
