

A special meeting of the Town of Denmark Town Board held on September 22, 2022, at the Town of Denmark Municipal Building regarding Public Safety.

Supervisor Doyle opened the Town Board meeting at 7:00pm. Those in attendance recited the Pledge of Allegiance.
